**Complications following prostate biopsy**

Prostate cancer is the no 1 cancer in Man (1) and no 2 cause of mortality in all male cancers (2). Trans Rectal Ultrasound Guided Biopsy (TRUSB) of the Prostate is the Gold standard for localising, volume measurement and tissue acquisition for prostate cancer. Infective sequel, form a significant part of the complications, sometimes serious or even fatal (rare). We present a retrospective audit on 100 consecutive TRUSB patients and analyse their infective complication rate. We are pleased to announce that our complication rates are well within the accepted (7%) as per world wide guidelines. In our study, TRUSB of prostate is a safe procedure.
